The prayer in the present petition under Section 483 read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is for the grant of interim regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.98 dated 07.06.2023 registered under Sections 21(c), (Section 25, 27 added later on) of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 & Sections 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Navi Baradari, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar, Punjab for a period of 4 weeks on account of surgery of his wife.

The status report dated 21.10.2024 alongwith custody certificate dated 11.10.2024 filed by the learned counsel for the State is taken on record.

Looking at the antecedents of the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to grant interim regular bail to the petitioner. However, in view

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of the fact that wife of the petitioner, namely, Rajinder Kaur is suffering from abdominal pain, diabetese and has been advised a surgery, the Jail Superintendent concerned is directed to send the petitioner/Jasvir Singh @ Padda in custody to the Civil Hospital, Kapurthala, w.e.f. 27.10.2024 till 04.11.2024 between 8.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m. daily. The expenses incurred for the aforesaid purpose shall be borne by the petitioner.

This petition stands disposed of.
