1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for grant of 'pre-arrest bail' to the petitioner in case FIR no.66, dated 23.06.2024 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 15/22 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (Section 29 added later on), registered at Police Station Shambhu, District Patiala.

2. The recovery of effected in the instant FIR from the co-accused is as under:-

- i. 500 grams of intoxicant powder,
- ii. 20 kg of poppy husk,
- iii. electronic scale colour yellow make Virgo Company,
- iv. 10 big plastic polythenes,
- v. 20 small transparent polythenes and packet of rubbers”
- vi. Rs.40,000/- of drug money

3. The petitioner is stated to be already involved in one other criminal case, though of not the similar nature. It is also transpired during investigation that the petitioner was in the constant touch with the main

accused, and it is fortified with the call details record (CDR) collected by prosecution agency during investigation, apart from the disclosure statement.

4. In view of the fact that the recovery, which has been effected in the instant FIR falls within the ambit of commercial quantity, this Court is not inclined to grant the relief of pre-arrest bail to the present. Therefore, the instant petition is, hereby, **dismissed**.

5. All pending applications, if any, also stand **disposed** of accordingly.
