Petitioner – Priti has filed petition under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023, for grant of regular bail in FIR No.264, dated 09.07.2024, under Sections 287, 49, 308(4), 111, 61(2) of BNS, 2023 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Ladwa, District Kurukshetra, Haryana.

2. As per the facts of case, Ankush Goyal filed written complaint alleging that he was running EDU SKOPE IELTS Studies Centre in Ladwa Town and is Vice-President of Bharatiya Janata Party. On 08.07.2024, he was sleeping in the house along with his family. At about 11:05 PM, door bell outside his house rang and from inside he saw two young boys were standing on the road outside the gate, one boy was on motorcycle and other boy holding a pistol in his hand was continuously firing in the air to spread terror. Entire incident was captured in CCTV camera. He could identify the said boys on seeing. With these allegations, present FIR has been registered. Later on during investigation, present petitioner was also



arrested.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner argued that she is falsely implicated in this case. She was not named in the FIR. She is named subsequently in the disclosure statement. She has no link with the alleged crime. Other co-accused Amandeep Kaur having similar allegations was granted bail in CRM-M-38506-2024 decided on 07.11.2024 (Annexure P-4) titled as "Amandeep Kaur Vs. State of Hayana". She was arrested in this case on 13.07.2024 and since then she is behind the bars. It is prayed that her regular bail application may be allowed.

4. Bail application is opposed by learned counsel representing State. It is pointed out that name of present petitioner came into picture during the investigation. On disclosure statement of present petitioner, mobile phone has been recovered which was allegedly used in the crime for giving whatsapp call to the other accused. She is named by co-accused Sonu Bakali along with other accused. There is CCTV footage of the occurrence in which Manpreet alias Mani and Varun alias Ashu alias Binda are clearly visible. It is pointed out that investigation is at initial stage. Main accused Varun alias Ashu alias Binda is yet to be arrested. Therefore, regular bail application filed by the petitioner may be dismissed.

5. I have considered arguments and have gone through the status report. Name of present petitioner came into picture, during investigation she is named by co-accused and is connected with the alleged crime on the basis of whatsapp call to the other accused persons. She has already joined the investigation and is behind the bars since 13.07.2024. Investigation in this case is yet to complete. Presentation of challan and trial may take some time.



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my mind on the merits of the case, regular bail petition filed by the petitioner – Priti is allowed. She is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Judge concerned.

- 7. The petition is accordingly, accepted.
- 8. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
