1. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Mr. Ravinder Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Moga City, submits that the amount due to the petitioner against his gold ornaments, in terms of order dated 17.08.2023 passed by the Court of learned CJM, Moga, shall be made available to him within a period of 04 weeks from today.
2. In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.
3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

However, it is made clear that in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the salary of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga as well as the Deputy Superintendent of
