ANIL KSHETARPAL, J

1. Central Board of Secondary Education, Panchkula, challenges the correctness of First Appellate Court's order refusing to condone the delay of 189 days in filing the appeal. The trial court decreed the plaintiff's suit permitting change of her name as well as date of birth.

2. While filing the appeal, the petitioner also prayed for condonation of delay of 189 days. Though, the application does not contain any plausible explanation for the delay. What has been stated in the application is that the delay in filing the appeal is due to the process of department which is not intentional.

3. This, in the opinion of the court, is no reason for condoning the delay of 189 days. Moreover, the petitioner has not filed any revised application.

4. Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.

5. Dismissed.

6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
