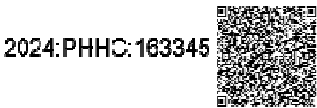

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to register an FIR under Sections 115, 116, 117(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (*for short 'BNS'*) against respondent No. 4 and to decide the representation dated 12.08.2024 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon. The petitioner has also prayed for issuing direction to the official respondents for conducting fair and impartial investigation in FIR No. 181 dated 09.07.2024, registered under Sections 115, 117(2) and 3(5) of BNS at Police Station Matlauda, District Panipat.
2. Reply has been filed by the respondent-State. It is submitted therein and learned State counsel has argued that the aforesaid representation/complaint of the petitioner was duly inquired into and was filed. With regard to aforesaid FIR No. 181, it is submitted that *challan* has



already been presented in the said case after conducting proper investigation in a fair and impartial manner.

3. Faced with the above facts, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to petitioner to avail his alternative remedies in accordance with law.

4. In view of the above, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
