The instant writ petition has been preferred by the petitioner for seeking issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to alter or insulate the overhead electricity line passing horizontally to the petitioner's property under Regulation 65 of the Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety of Electric Supply) Regulation, 2023. An alternative prayer has also been made for directing the respondents to decide the application dated 02.07.2024 (Annexure P-6 sent by the petitioner.

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2 At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the competent authority to decide the application dated 02.07.2024 (Annexure P-6) sent by the petitioner by passing a speaking and reasoned order in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3 Notice of motion.

4 Mr. Kunal Garg, Advocate, enters appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that he has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

5 Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction that the competent authority shall take a decision on the representation sent by the petitioner and in case the same is not received by them, then by treating the present writ petition as a representation on behalf of the petitioner by passing a speaking and reasoned order thereupon in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.
