1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 528 read with Section 482, 490, 491 of BNSS 2023 seeking quashing of order dated 18.07.2024 Annexure P-1 passed by the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Chandigarh vide which the bail of the petitioner was cancelled and he directed to be summoned through non bailable warrants of arrest, on account of his absence before the trial Court on the date fixed in a criminal case having FIR No.151 dated 05.06.2023 under Section 174-A IPC, Police Station Sector-36, Chandigarh.

2. Counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that petitioner was granted regular bail vide order dated 26.07.2023 Annexure P-2 by the Court concerned and thereafter, the petitioner was regularly appearing in the trial proceedings but got absented on 18.07.2024 due to noting down of wrong date of hearing. The absence of the petitioner was not intentional at all and the petitioner is ready to join the proceedings before the trial Court at the earliest.



3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Tarunvir Lehal, Addl. P.P., UT Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that the petitioner who was earlier granted regular bail, got absented and resultantly, impugned order dated 18.07.2024 Annexure P-1 was passed by the learned trial Court in accordance with law.
5. In light of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and in order to avoid any further delay in trial, the petitioner is hereby directed to join proceedings before the trial Court within next 10 days and on his doing so, the petitioner is to be released on regular bail by the Court concerned to its own satisfaction and subject to cost of Rs.5000/- to be deposited by the petitioner with the Poor Patient Welfare Fund, PGIMER, Chandigarh.
6. Disposed of in aforesaid terms.
