1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (*replaced with Section 482 of the Code of
Criminal Procedure, 1973*) is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to
4 to complete the investigation and present the status report in FIR No.3 dated
12.01.2017 under Sections 376B & 342 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860,
registered at Police Station Cantt. Bathinda, District Bathinda, before the Court
of learned Illaqa Magistrate, Bathinda in a time bound manner.
2. At the very outset, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI
Sukhmander Singh, submits that grievance raised by the petitioner in the

present petition has substantially been redressed. Initially, the investigating agency filed the cancellation report before the jurisdictional Court, which was not accepted and it was sent back by the concerned Court and thereafter, Special Investigation Team headed by Superintendent of Police again investigated the matter and thoroughly examined the veracity of the allegations made by the petitioner and her version was found to be false. Accordingly, the cancellation report was again prepared and the same has already been presented before learned jurisdictional Court on 07.08.2024 and now the matter is pending before the jurisdictional Court.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to invoke the alternative remedy as available to her, in accordance with law.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
