1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to redress her grievance which she has raised in her representations dated 13.05.2024 (Annexure P-2) and 23.07.2024 (Annexure P-3).

2. The petitioner claims that she is a senior citizen and there is overflow of sewerage water in front of her house which is creating unhygienic atmosphere. Due to this she may be physically affected. She has filed representations to local authorities but of no avail.

3. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, who on advance notice is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and waives service. He assures the Court that Competent Authority would look into the grievance of petitioner raised in the representations and the same would be redressed.
