Leave is granted to place on record still photographs showing plantation of 20 saplings of indigenous plants by the petitioners as Annexure P-24 in compliance of the order dated 27.09.2024 passed by this Court and the application is allowed.

1. The petitioners apprehending their arrest have filed this petition under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 100, dated 13.08.2024 under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.



2. This Court vide order dated 27.09.2024 had granted anticipatory to the petitioners with certain terms and conditions.
3. Learned State counsel has filed status report of Sh. Gurdev Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (West), Ludhiana which is taken on record. He does not dispute that the petitioners have joined and cooperated during investigation and also that they have filed documentary proof in the shape of photographs as regards plantation of trees.
4. In view of the above, the interim order dated 27.09.2024 granting anticipatory bail to the petitioners stands confirmed on the same terms and conditions as mentioned therein.
5. The petition stands disposed of.
