Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions from
respondent No. 2, submits that the benefits payable to the petitioner stands
transferred in his account, thereby rendering the present petition as
infructuous.

[2] In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does
not press the present petition any further.

[3] Dismissed as not pressed.

[4] However, in case the needful is not done, as per undertaking,
the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt
petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be
liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket
in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on
the first date of listing of revival application.
