By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case
FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance to the order dated 27.09.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such interim bail granted to the petitioner may be confirmed.
3. Learned State counsel on the basis of *pairvi* report received from SI Ajit Singh has intimated that the petitioner has joined investigation



and is no more required for any custodial investigation in this case nor he is required for further investigation.

4. Heard.

5. During the course of hearing on 27.09.2024, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that the petitioner has been involved in the instant case due to misunderstanding. Compromise has been effected between the parties (Annexure P-2) wherein it is specifically mentioned that due to misunderstanding the dispute arose between the parties and name of the petitioner has wrongly been registered on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused. He further submits that quashing petition of the instant FIR has also been filed i.e. CRM-M-45103- 2024 in which notice of motion has already been issued for 02.12.2024.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Karan Sharma, DAG, Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and seeks time to file status report. A copy of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 02.12.2024.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when called by SHO/Investigating Officer and in the event of his arrest, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating Agency, subject to the following conditions as envisaged under Section 482 of BNSS:-

(i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation before the investigating officer as and when required:

(ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;

(iii) that the petitioner shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court concerned. Status report be filed on or before the next date of hearing with an advance copy to the counsel opposite.

To be heard along with CRM-M-45103-2024.”

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State

counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 27.09.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 27.09.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.
