The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to regularise the services of the petitioners with effect from 05.08.2014 along with all benefits of regularisation and arrears as the similar situated employees have already been granted the same benefit.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case second respondent is directed to decide their pending representation dated 20.03.2024, Annexure

P-4, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Krishan K. Chahal, Addl. Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice and submits that pending representation, dated 20.03.2024, will be decided by the second respondent expeditiously.
5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the second respondent-Director General, Secondary Education to consider and decide the pending representation, dated 20.03.2024, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of three months of receiving a certified copy of this order.
6. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioners.
