1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking writ of mandamus, directing the respondent No.2 to re-fix the salary of the petitioner at par with his junior.
2. Pursuant to receipt of advance copy of the petition, learned State counsel has put in appearance and produced copy of order dated 01.10.2024, whereby the claim of the petitioner for fixing his pay at par with his junior has been rejected. Copy of order dated 01.10.2024 is taken on record.
2. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action with better particulars and by impugning the order dated 01.10.2024.
