After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the wife of the petitioner is working at Guru Harsahai and being a couple case, the petitioner was transferred from Tarn Taran to Fazilka but the said transfer has been cancelled now which is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there are posts which are lying vacant near Fazilka and Ferozepur where the petitioner can be adjusted so that he can have stable family life as well. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner intends to approach the respondents by filing an appropriate representation and the respondents be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner so that the petitioner does not suffer any prejudice.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation is received at the hands of the petitioners, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of three weeks from the receipt of any such representation/claim by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
