Reply by way of an affidavit of Inderpal Chauhan, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Patran, District Patiala filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 is taken on record along with copies of statements of both the petitioners as Annexure R-1 and Annexure R-2.

2. Learned State counsel while referring to Annexure R-1 and Annexure R-2 submits that both the petitioners made statements before the police to the effect that now they are not apprehending any threat from the side of private respondents or any other person and are residing together peacefully. The State counsel further submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous in the light of the aforesaid



statements Annexure R-1 and Annexure R-2 and be disposed of accordingly.

- 3. Ordered accordingly.
- 4. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the relationship, if any, is there between the petitioners. It is also made clear that respondents No.4 to 10 are at liberty to avail appropriate remedy available to them under law against the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
