Counsel for the petitioner submits that respondents No.6 and 7, who are husband and wife took huge amount from petitioner on the pretext of sending him abroad but thereafter they failed to do the needful and also refused to return the amount. The matter was reported to the police in writing and thereafter reminders were also sent, which are Annexure P-2 to Annexure P-4 but till date police failed to take any action against respondents No.6 and 7. Being aggrieved, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of necessary directions to official respondents No.1 to 5 to proceed in this matter, in accordance with law.

3. Mr. Jasjeet Singh Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on



behalf of respondents No.1 to 5 and on instructions from ASI Bhupinder Singh submits that on completion of inquiry, the concerned Deputy Superintendent of Police has recommended for registration of FIR against respondents No.6 and 7 and approval of Senior Superintendent of Police concerned is still awaited, in this regard.

4. In light of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) to look into the matter and decide representations already given by the petitioner, in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
