1. Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to release the amount of bills dated 22.03.2021 to 18.12.2022 qua the works of maintenance executed by the petitioner.
2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 12.08.2024 (Annexure P-4) but the respondents have neither paid the outstanding dues to the petitioner nor have they taken any action upon the said representation.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Vivek Saini, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and prays for some time to complete the instructions and file response, if necessary.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, contends that he would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.4-Executive Engineer, Public Health Engineering, Division No.1, Kaimri Road, Hisar is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 12.08.2024 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.



6. Learned State counsel has no objection to the request made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
7. Accordingly, in view of the above; with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.4-Executive Engineer, Public Health Engineering, Division No.1, Kaimri Road, Hisar to consider and decide the representation dated 12.08.2024 (Annexure P-4) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.
8. Needless to mention that upon considering the said representation, if any amount is found due and payable to the petitioner, the same shall be disbursed in favour of the petitioner within a further period of three months.
9. In the event of non-payment of dues within the said period, the same shall be released along with interest @ 6% per annum to be paid to the petitioner and subject to additional payment of a cost of Rs.50,000/- to be deposited with the Poor Patient Welfare Fund (PPWF) of Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education & Research, Chandigarh. The said additional financial liability of accrued interest and cost shall be subject to recovery from the erring official.
10. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
