Short reply by way of an affidavit of Dilpreet Singh, IPS, Assistant Superintendent of Police, Dinanagar, Gurdaspur filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 is taken on record along with copy of statement of husband of petitioner No.1 (Annexure R-1).

2. Learned State counsel apprised the Court that husband of petitioner No.1 is having no objection to the relationship if any maintained by his wife i.e. petitioner No.1 with petitioner No.2.

3. Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petition be disposed of in light of the aforesaid statement made by husband of petitioner No.1.

4. Ordered accordingly.



5. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the relationship, if any, is there between the petitioners. It is also made clear that respondent No.4 is at liberty to avail appropriate remedy available to him under law against the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
