- 1. Counsel for the petitioner while restricting his arguments submits that the petitioner will be satisfied if necessary direction is given to respondent No.3 to consider and decide his representation Annexure P-3 dated 05.09.2024 as per law, at the earliest. However, the averments made in the present petition be also considered as part of the said representation.
- 2. Notice of motion.
- 3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and submitted that in case any complaint/representation(s) has been filed, the concerned authorities will consider and decide the same as per law.
- 4. Counsel for the petitioner is agreed to the aforesaid proposal.

In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide representation dated 05.09.2024 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. However, it is made clear that contents of the present petition be also taken into consideration by respondent No.3 while looking into and deciding the matter in question. The petitioner is directed to appear before respondent No.3 and to provide copy of the present petition within next 7 days.
