1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.1131, dated 23.12.2023, under Sections 34/406/420 of IPC, registered at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that in compliance of the order dated 30.09.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.
