Compliance report has been filed on behalf of
respondent No.1, similarly short reply on behalf of respondent No.2
has also been filed and the same are taken on record.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents on instructions
from Mr. Ashwani Kumar Dogra, General Manager, Roadways
informs that though monetary benefits have already been released in
favour of the petitioner, however, the interest component shall be
released to her within a period of two weeks from today.

3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by learned counsel for
the respondents, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the
present petition.

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4. Dismissed as not pressed.
5. Rule stands discharged.
6. However, in case the needful is not done within the
aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at
liberty to seek revival of the contempt petition and in that eventuality,
the erring/concerned Officer would be liable to pay Rs.50,000/- as costs
from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation
expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival
application.
