1. In the present writ petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the salary from 13.07.2021 to 26.07.2021 has not been released to the petitioner and that too without any valid justification.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance with regard to the non-release of the salary has already been raised by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 08.07.2024 (Annexure P-11) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

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4. Mr. Satnam Preet Singh, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and Mr. Abhimanyu Batish, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2.

5. Learned State counsel submits that in case the legal notice dated 08.07.2024 (Annexure P-11) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
