AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner Yash Sharma has filed petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release of detainee i.e. Rinki from the illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 6.

2. Today, petitioner (Yash Sharma), alleged detainee (Rinki) and respondent No.5 (Rajat Kumar), brother of Rinki are present in the Court. Rinki confirmed that she got married with Yash Sharma on 22.05.2024 and due to matrimonial dispute she had gone back to her parental house. Now the matter has been reconciled between her and her husband.

3. At this stage, learned counsel for petitioner stated that in view of the aforesaid factual position, he has instructions to withdraw the present petition.



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4. In view of the statement, present petition is accordingly dismissed and withdrawn.
