Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.371 dated 22.06.2024 registered under Section 365 of IPC at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat, Haryana (Annexure P-1).

In compliance of the previous order, status report dated 17.10.2024 by way of affidavit of Mr. Satish Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarter Panipat has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State along with Annexure R-1 to R-4, which is taken on record. Copy has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the previous order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police.

State counsel on instructions from ASI, Harmesh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

From the perusal of Annexure P-2 it appears that the victim Mausam in her statement under Section 164 Cr.PC has not stated anything against the present petitioner. Further it has been brought to the notice of the Court that now Mausam has attained the age of the maturity.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 27.09.2024 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
