Reply by way of an affidavit of Satnam Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 is taken on record along with copies of statements of both the petitioners as Annexure R-1 and Annexure R-2 respectively.

2. Learned State counsel while referring to Annexure R-1 and Annexure R-2 submits that both the petitioners got recorded their statements with the police to the effect that both of them are living together happily and are not facing any danger to their life and liberty from the side of private respondents.



3. Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petition be disposed of in light of the aforesaid Annexure R-1 and Annexure R-2 coupled with statement made by the State counsel.
4. Ordered accordingly.
5. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the relationship, if any, is there between the petitioners. It is also made clear that respondents No.4 and 5 are at liberty to avail appropriate remedy available to them under law against the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
