1. The present petition has been filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for wilful disobedience of order dated 11.05.2023 passed by this Court in CWP 10242-2023.
2. Compliance report dated 06.12.2023 by way of affidavit of Harinder Singh, Executive Engg. - Respondent No. 5, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the respondents have made the payment of principal amount and, therefore, the present petition has become infructuous. However, the petitioner may be granted liberty to raise the claim qua interest on the delayed payment.
4. In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
5. However, if any of the grievances of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law,
