Status report by way of affidavit of Bharpur Singh, PPS, Deputy
Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sunam, District Sangrur has been
filed on behalf of respondent No.1-State and the same is taken on record.

On 05.12.2023, following order was passed:

*Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record
the copy of the order dated 16.11.2023 passed by this Court in
CRM-M54683-2023, whereby co-accused Amrit Pal Singh S/o
Rajinder Singh, has been granted the benefit of anticipatory
bail.*

Adjourned to 29.01.2024 for filing status report.

*In the meantime, petitioner is directed to join
investigation and co-operate in the same. He will not leave the
country without prior permission of the Court nor shall make
any attempt to contact the complainant of the case or any
witness associated with the case. In the event of the arrest of the
petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing*

personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Today learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sham Singh, submits that petitioner has since joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case order dated 05.12.2023 is hereby made absolute, whereby petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
