In the present petition, grievance of the petitioner is that she is seeking benefit of family pension after the death of her husband who unfortunately died on 17.09.2020 but she is not being paid her entitled family pension and other benefits, which is causing prejudice to her and hence, the respondents are liable to be directed to grant the petitioner benefit of her entitled pension as well as other benefits along with interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has already raised said grievance in the representation dated 05.07.2024 (Annexure P/7), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amar Preet Singh Bains, AAG,

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Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation dated 05.07.2024 (Annexure P/7) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be conveyed to the petitioner for her information and necessary action.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
