HARKESH MANUJA, J.(Oral)

Learned counsel for the respondent on instructions from Mr. Om Dutt, Executive Engineer, M. C. Faridabad submits that a sum of Rs.6,15,951/- has been found due towards the petitioner against his bills; besides it he will also be paid 6% interest on account of delayed disbursement from the date of submission of final bill till the date of actual disbursal.

2. Learned State counsel further assures that the needful shall be done with ten working days from today.

3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by learned counsel for the respondent, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.



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- 4. Dismissed as not pressed.
- 5. Rule stands discharged.
- 6. However, in case the needful is not done within the
aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would
be at liberty to seek revival of the contempt petition and in that
eventuality, the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Faridabad
would be liable to pay Rs.1 lakh as costs from his/her own pocket in
favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e.
on the first date of listing of revival application.
