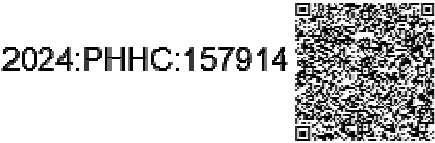

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 to 4 to decide the representation dated 23.08.2024 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner and take necessary action in terms of the same.

2. Upon notice, short reply by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Majitha, Amritsar has been filed today in Court, which is taken on record. It is submitted therein and learned State counsel has argued that after conducting a thorough inquiry on the complaint/representation of the petitioner, no substance was found in the allegations levelled therein. Hence, the aforesaid representation has been filed.

3. Since the representation of the petitioner stands duly inquired



into by the police authorities and stands filed as no substance was found in the same, the present petition is disposed of as no further orders are called for.

4. However, the petitioner is granted liberty to avail her alternative remedy in accordance with law, if so advised.
