1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 05.09.2019 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Divn), Jalandhar vide which an application filed by the petitioner/defendant has been dismissed.
