MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.275 dated 01.09.2023 under Sections 406, 420 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Khol, District Rewari.

2. On the last date of hearing, i.e. 12.10.2023, while noticing the following submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked her to join investigation.

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the only allegation levelled against the petitioner is that on the assurance of the petitioner as well as co-accused, an amount of ₹ 6 lakh was given to one Ashwani for getting her daughter employed with the Railways.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 12.10.2023, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for her custodial interrogation.

5. In the circumstances, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 12.10.2023 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Needless to say, in case the petitioner misuses the concession of bail granted to her, the State would be at liberty to seek cancellation of the bail granted to her.
