RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 14.09.2023 passed in CWP-13069-2023.
2. Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that on 14.09.2023, the petitioner was on leave.
3. However, counsel for the respondent has disputed the same.
4. Since the order passed by the Writ Court was only to maintain status quo, therefore, in view of the above disputed questions of fact being involved in the present petition, this Court does not find it appropriate to interfere in the matter.
5. Dismissed.
6. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to raise his grievance before the Writ Court where the writ petition is stated to be still pending adjudication.
