MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the appellant informs the Court that despite repeated efforts, the appellant could not be contacted nor he ever approached him after the filing of the present Civil Appeal and thus, he has no further instructions from his client qua this appeal.

A perusal of the file reveals that on 11.08.2023, learned counsel for the appellant had submitted before the Co-ordinate Bench that he had not been able to get in touch with his client and vide the order as passed on that day, notice was ordered to be issued to the appellant for 27.09.2023 and on the said date, the Registry had reported that the notice issued to the appellant had been served through his father but none had appeared in the Court to represent the appellant. Thereafter, on 14.11.2023 and 19.01.2024 as well, the appellant had remained unrepresented.

In view the afore-discussed facts and circumstances, this Court is left with no other option but to dismiss the instant appeal for the want of prosecution. Resultantly, the same stands dismissed accordingly.
