1. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are unnecessarily harassed time and again by the police at the instance of respondents No.7 and 8 who are making false complaints against the petitioners. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that the police should not unnecessarily harass the petitioners and should follow due course as prescribed under law, even if any criminal complaint has been lodged against the petitioners by respondents No.7 and 8.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Jasjeet Singh Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 6 and on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh submits the no doubt one complaint (Annexure P-1) has been lodged by respondents No.7 and 8 against the present petitioners with the police but the police is not unnecessarily harassing the petitioners as has



been alleged in the present petition. The matter is being enquired into in accordance with law and in case there will be any requirement of the petitioners then proper notice as per provisions of law will be issued to the petitioners.

4. Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners made prayer that the present petition be disposed of, in light of the aforesaid statement made by learned State counsel.

5. Ordered accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case.
