Learned counsel for the respondents has produced a copy of speaking order dated 28.10.2024 passed by the Divisional Wildlife Officer, Panchkula, whereby the petitioner has been found eligible and entitled for regularization. He, on instructions from Mr. Rajender Prasad, Divisional Wildlife Officer, Panchkula, submits that the order of regularization shall be passed in favour of the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today. The aforesaid order dated 28.10.2024 is taken on record and copy thereof has been supplied to the opposite side.

[2] In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[3] Dismissed as not pressed.

[4] However, in case the needful is not done, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

[5] Rule stands discharged.
