Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to carry out a fair and impartial investigation in the FIR No.116 dated 01.09.2024 from any other impartial independent agency as respondent No.3 who is Investigating Officer of the said FIR is biased and favouring the accused and respondent No.4 who is Sub Inspector in the same Police Station, has been influencing the investigation of the said FIR.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that occurrence in the present case had taken place in June, 2024, whereas, the FIR was registered on 01.09.2024. He submits that respondent-accused are very much available but despite that the Investigating Agency is not proceeding with the investigation.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Karunesh Kaushal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. He has submitted that the investigation is already going on and till date out of four accused, three accused have been arrested and have already been granted bail and only respondent No.5- Harjit Singh remains to be arrested. He further submits that every effort to arrest Harjit Singh is being made by the

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Investigating Agency. He further submits that the investigation would be completed within a period of two months from today.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Investigating Agency to conclude the investigation in accordance with law within a period of two months from today.
