1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 read with Section 2(b) of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 16.01.2023 passed in CWP-4403-2011.

2. Reply dated 26.02.2024 by way of affidavit of Gaurav Yadav, IPS, Director General of Police, Punjab Police Headquarters, filed in the Court today, is taken on record.

3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 16.01.2023 passed in CWP-4403-2011 has been complied with; speaking order dated 15.02.2024 has been passed and necessary payment has been released in favour of the petitioner.

4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-
addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate
remedy, but in accordance with law.
