This petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the order dated 01.03.2024, Annexure P-23, and action of the respondents in not releasing the salary of the petitioner during the period from 07.02.2023 to 09.08.2023, despite the creation of supernumerary post on 02.02.2023, Annexure P-9, on the basis of hundred per cent disability of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the third respondent is directed to decide the pending legal notice, dated 16.05.2024, Annexure P-30, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.



4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice and submits that the pending legal notice shall be decided by the third respondent expeditiously.
5. In view thereof, without going into merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the third respondent-Director General, Secondary Education, to consider and decide the pending legal notice, dated 16.05.2024, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
6. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
