Learned trial court has dismissed the petitioner's application for grant of visitation rights on the ground that till date no reply to the main petition has been filed. It has been observed that the petitioner can file appropriate application, after filing the reply. However, the petitioner filed an appeal against the aforesaid order, which has also been dismissed. In this Court, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court in order to resolve the controversy, however, the parties have failed to arrive at an amicable settlement.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that there are child welfare guidelines, which require the court to refer the matter for mediation.

This Court has considered the submissions made by the learned counsel representing the parties.

The matter has already been referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court but efforts have failed.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to interfere is made out.

Hence, dismissed.

The petitioner, if so advised, may file his reply to the main petition before the trial court.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
