SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

- 1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of impugned order dated 12.06.2024 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.3.
- 2. Reply filed by way of an affidavit of Navinder Singh, PPS, Superintendent District Jail Sangrur is taken on record.
- 3. Perusal of the reply would reveal that the petitioner is seeking parole in FIR No.84 dated 20.05.2013, wherein he has already completed his sentence.
- 4. In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
- 5. Disposed off, as having been rendered infructuous.
- 6. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to move an application before the Competent Authority, in any other case, in which he is facing conviction for the purpose of seeking parole and the authority concerned would decide the same in accordance with law expeditiously.
