SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 528 BNSS of 2023 for directing the official respondents to investigate the representation (Annexure P-2) dated 12.03.2024 and representation dated 01.05.2024 (Annexure P-3) and to take appropriate legal action as per law against the respondents No.6 and 7 who have wrongly, illegally and forcibly detained the vehicle of the petitioner and further the official respondents be directed to get release the vehicle of petitioner from the illegal custody of respondent No.6 and same be handed over to the petitioner.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala to decide the representations dated 12.03.2024 and 01.05.2024 along with assertions made in the legal notice dated 19.07.2024 within a time bound manner.

Without adverting to the merits of the case, the respondent respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala is directed to consider and to decide the representations dated 12.03.2024 and 01.05.2024 along with assertions made in the legal notice dated 19.07.2024 by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within one week thereafter.
