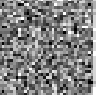

NAMIT KUMAR, J (ORAL)

The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking the following reliefs:-

“(i) Issue of writ, order or direction in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside/quashing of the order bearing memo No.12/11/2018-2ss3/1512433/1 dated 01.07.2019 (Annexure P-9) wherein in a patently illegal and arbitrary manner the claim of the petitioner for protection of his pay as per last pay drawn has been wrongly rejected in contravention to the Govt. Instructions dated 15.11.2000 (Annexure P-11), 15.01.2015 (Annexure P-12) and clarification dated 25.09.2017 (Annexure P-14) and the relevant Punjab Civil Services Rules i.e. Rule 4.4 (b) Volume-I, Part-I.

(ii) Further issuance of writ, order or direction in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 4 to pay the arrears of pay as per last pay drawn (Annexure P-6)/pay protection w.e.f. January, 2019 till 15th August 2019 (till when



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the petitioner worked) alongwith interest/penalty on delayed payment of salary for the months of July, 2018 to December, 2018”.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner does not press the relief claimed in clause (i) of the relief clause of the petition. With regard to relief claimed in clause (ii), he submits that he may be given liberty to file a detailed representation to respondent No.4 and the same may be considered and disposed of in a time bound manner.

If any such representation is submitted by the petitioner within a period of one month from today, the same shall be considered and disposed of by respondent No.4, within a period of three months thereafter, after affording an opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner and if the petitioner is found entitled to the claim, the same shall be released to the petitioner, within a period of one month thereafter.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the liberty aforesaid.
