

of her house was locked inside and when with the help of family of landlord she got opened the door she found that Gurbinderpal Singh was lying on the floor of bathroom and bleeding was present near his eye. In the meantime, someone called the Doctor. After examining said Gurbinderpal Singh, doctor declared him already dead. Postmortem of deceased was got conducted from Civil Hospital, Moga. As per postmortem report there were 12 injuries on person of the deceased. In the postmortem report, Doctor has mentioned that cause of death can be given only after getting the report from Chemical Examiner and pathology report. However, as per report of the Chemical Examiner no poison detected in the content of Exhibit I, II, III, IV and V.

(4) That after completion of investigation, said report was presented before the SDM, Moga and same was approved by the SDM, Moga, on 20.06.2023 without conducting any enquiry under section 176 Cr.P.C.

(5) That after getting the reports from the Chemical Examiner and Pathology report from Guru Gobind Singh Medical College and Hospital, Faridkot, opinion from the board of Doctors was obtained regarding cause of death. After considering all the reports, the Doctors have given their opinion dated 03.11.2023, in which they have mentioned that cause of death in this case is due to Asphyxia as result of strangulation and shock and haemorrhage, due to injuries mentioned in the Postmortem report. After getting opinion from DA (L), Moga, case bearing FIR No.273 dated 07.12.2023 under section 302/34 IPC Police Station City Moga has been registered against Rupinder Kaur wife of Late Gurinderpal Singh, Germon Singh son of Pargat Singh, Harman Singh son of Pargat Singh and Pargat Singh, on the basis of statement of petitioner.

(6) That for conducting the thorough investigation of the case, Special Investigating Team consisting of SP (PBI), Moga, DSP (City), Moga and SHO (City), has been constituted vide order no.1585-1589-R-SSP Dated 12.12.2023 passed by SSP, Moga.”

- 3. In view of the above, the action having been taken by the State authorities, no further order is required to be passed.
- 4. Accordingly, petition is disposed off.
- 5. Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed off.
