1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to take legal action against respondent Nos. 3 and 4 and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondent Nos. 3 and 4.
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed an application on 28.09.2023 (*Annexure P-2*) before respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur raising his grievances as raised in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to decide the aforesaid application filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.

3. Learned State counsel submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to her during the course of the day, if not supplied earlier.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforesaid application of the petitioner within a period of one month from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law. Needless to say, if any threat is found to the petitioner, the official respondents would provide him adequate security in order to protect his life and liberty.
