1. The present petition under Section 528 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (for short- 'BNSS'), 2023 has been preferred by the petitioner seeking directions to the official respondents No.2 to 4 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in case arising out of FIR No.17 dated 02.03.2024 registered under Sections 341, 323, 506 and 34 of IPC at P.S. Sudhar, District Ludhiana, in accordance with law and further for issuance of directions to respondents No.3 and 4 to record the supplementary statement of the petitioner.

2. It is, inter alia, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the present FIR had been registered against Jaspreet Singh, Gurjeet Singh and Harbans Singh, but till date no action thereon has been taken. The petitioner had moved the representation (Annexure P-8) dated 05.09.2024 in this regard to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Ludhiana (Rural), but till date, no action thereon has been taken. He further submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate



directions are given to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana (Rural), to consider and dispose of the representation dated 05.09.2024 (Annexure P-8) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Akshay Kumar, A.A.G, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.
5. Heard.
6. After considering the respective submissions and considering the averments made in the petition, without commenting on the merits thereof, the present petition is, hereby, disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Ludhiana (Rural), to consider and dispose of the representation (Annexure P-8) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.
7. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner.
