1. This is the 2nd petition filed by the petitioner under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in:-

2. Upon instructions, State counsel has apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined and co-operated with the investigation. Still further, he submits that he is no longer required for custodial interrogation. He could not dispute that no recovery has been effected from the petitioner although as per the disclosure statement of the co-accused, the contraband was delivered to the petitioner.

3. In view of the above, without commenting upon the merits of the allegations, present petition is allowed and order dated 13.10.2023 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the satisfaction of the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
