1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to pay 3rd ACP and basic pay as per the Government guidelines alongwith all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had filed a legal notice dated 12.02.2024 (Annexure P-4) to the respondents but the same has not been considered and decided till date. He further submitted that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case the aforesaid legal notice dated 12.02.2024 (Annexure P-4) is considered and decided by the respondents in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.



4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. She submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, she has no objection in case time bound direction is issued in this regard.

5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for the reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Managing Director/Competent Authority of respondent-Nigam to consider and decide the legal notice dated 12.02.2024 (Annexure P-4) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
